## The Tornado File Transfer Tool

Copying/transferring large directories and files from one PC/laptop to another is always painful and time-consuming. USB storage devices work for small files, but large ones force you to copy them from your source computer on to an external hard drive and then from there to your destination computer. Or, you can use several web-based online storage services—usually for a fee. I have always wondered why someone hasn't invented a simple USB cable that connects two computers. My prayers have finally been answered.

We strongly recommend you buy a must-have device called The Tornado (<http://www.thetornado.com/site/home.shtml>). Developed by folks at Data Drive Thru (<http://www.datadrivethru.com/>), and priced at \$59.95, this device is easy to use and elegant. With no software or device drivers to install, you just connect the ends of this USB 2.0 device to your source and destination computers. Immediately pops up a window displaying all the contents of the two computers. Now you can drag and drop directories/files from one computer to another to your heart's content. It is that easy. I tried it with my two laptops and desktop, and it worked beautifully. Why didn't anyone think of a device like this before will always surprise me!

Currently, The Tornado can be purchased only from the company's website, but we have been told it will be available through major retailers in early 2007.
